THE GUARDIA NEWS LETTER N: 107 - (23 JUNE TO JULY 8, 1932).

- 23 JUNE 1932 -

Lieuts Stattery, Perez, Rocha with seventeen enlisted and two civil prisoners arrived Jinotega from half-way Matagalpa.
