GUARDIA NEWS LETTER Nº 71 (22 OCTOBER TO 29 OCTOBER 1931)

(On account of inclement weather no reports from the Central Area were received during the week; will be included in next week's letter).

22 OCTOBER 1931

Lieut Brown and Yalaguina (NA) guardia patrol cleared Yalaguina for and arrived Totogalpa. Cleared Totogalpa and returned to Yalaguina.

Captain Williams and Somoto (NA) guardia patrol cleared Somoto for and arrived Ocotal.

Lieut Muñoz and San Juan do Telpaneca (NA) guardia patrol cleared San Juan for and arrivel Apali.

Lieut Martinez and Pueblo Nuevo (NA) guardia patrol cleared Pueblo Nuevo for and arrived Condega. Cleared Condega and returned to Pueblo Nuevo.

Lieut Bilbrey and Jicaro (NA) guardia patrol cleared Apali for and arrived Jicaro.

Lieut Clark and Daraili (NA) guardia patrol arrived Condega from Daraili. Reports having repaired telephone line which was cut at a point near Santa Rosa.

Lieut Burt and Totogalpa (NA) guardia patrol cleared Totogalpa for Yalaguina to operate from there in vicinity of La Muta in conjunction with Yalaguina patrol. Patrol arrived.

Lieut Kipp and Palacaguina (NA) guardia patrol returned to Palacaguina. Reports having located and destroyed guaro still; also confiscated quantity of guaro and arrested two operators.

24 OCTOBER 1931

Lieut Brown, Lieut Burt and combined Yalaguina and Totogalpa (NA) guardia patrol cleared on combat mission in La Muta.

Lieut Brown and Yalaguina (NA) guardia patrolhad contact with small bandit group near La Muta. Bandit casualties unknown. No guardia casualties. Burned two small bandit camps. Captured 8 rounds krag ammuntion, 1 cutacha, 1 cartridge belt, 1 raincoat several blankets and articles of clothing including shoes. Also a commission of Felicito Prado as Captain, signed by Sandino.

Lieut Berueffy and Dipilto (NA) guardia patrol cleared Dipilto for and arrived Ocotal.

Captain Williams, Lieut Jackson and Semoto (NA) guardia patrol cleared Ocetal for Jometo via Totogalpa. Privat Cotogalpa and cleared for and prived Someto.

Lieut Prosper and Jalapa (TA) guardia patrol cleared Apali for Jalapa.

Lieut Titsworth and Esteli (NA) (uardia patrol, with seven civilians, cleared Esteli, with cargo, for Regadillok to meet halfway patrol from Limay.

Lieut Burt and Totogalpa (NA) guardia patrol returned to Totogalpa from combat mission.

Captain Frisbie, Lieut Truesdale and Quilali (NA) guardia patrol had contact with bandit group of twenty-five, under Roque Vargæ on October 23, near Las Cruces. Group mostly armed with cutachas and pistols. Captured 1 pistol, bandit letter and other miscellaneous articles. No guardia casualties. Bandit casualties; four killed (Personally counted) and one other believed killed and several wounded.

Lieut Kipp and Palacaguina (NA) guardia patrol cleared for Ducali Grande on police mission. Returned, nothing to report.

Lieut Brown and Yalaguina (NA) guardia patrol cleared for La Encuentros on combat mission.

Lieut Kalman and Somotollo (NA) guardia patrol returned to Somotillo from Santo Tomas and vicinity; captured one known bandit and agent of Jose Leon Diaz, with 1 firearm.

Esteli and Limay patrols returned to home stations after meeting halfway.

Lieut Diaz and Macuelizo (NA) quardia patrol cleared for Suyatal via Ococona to investigate reports that Umanzor and his group were in that vicinity. Returned and reported . . . mo evidence of bandits in the area covered.

Lieut Zamora and Daraili (NA) guardia patrol cleared Daraili for vicinity of Laguna Escondida to investigate report of bandits being in that vicinity.

Lieut Price, Lieut Jackson and Somoto (NA) guardia patrol clear ed Somoto for Pueblo Nuevo via Yalaguina.

La Trinidad (NA) guardia patrol cleared La Trinidad for Ferrero Blanco on police mission.

Lieut Vogel and Pataste (NA) guardia patrol cleared Pataste ic and arrived Somoto.

Lieut A. Cuadra cleared Leon for Nagarote and La Paz Centro on temporary duty.

Lieut Rodriguez, Lieut McClur and a detachment of guardia en route from Bluefields to Neptune Mine for duty had contact with a group of bandits, number and jefe unknown. Seven bandits killed. No guardia casualties. No other details yet.

Lieut Gaitan and Puerto Cabezas (EA) guardia patrol had contact with a group of fifty bandits, under Chavarria, at Cuyutinge One guardia killed. Seven bandits killed. No other details yet.

Lieut Stephenson and Kisalaya (EA) guardia patrol had contact at Saulalla with a large group of bandits, reported under Altamirano No guardia casualties. Four bandits killed. No other details yet.

Lieut Hennrich and Santa Maria (NA) guardia patrol returned to Santa Maria from eastern vicinity of the district of Santa Emilia. Reports all quiet in area covered.

Lieut Bilbrey and Jicaro (NA) guardia patrol cleared Jicaro for Cacao and vicinity on combat mission.

Lieut Vogel and Pataste (NA) guardia patrol cleared Somoto for Pataste.

Lieut Price, Lieut Jackson and Somoto (NA) guardia patrol cleared Pueblo Nuevo for Somoto.

Captain Brauer and Palacaguina (NA) guardia patrol cleared Palacaguina for and arrived Condega.

La Trinidad (nA) guardia _atr. returned to La Trinidad from Ferreno Blanco; nothing to report.

Reports that at Cucavales a group of seventy five, mostly young boys, armed with rifles, pistols, three Thomposn guns and one Browning automatic rifle, spent the night of October 26 at Las Nudes. At Las Nuces the patrol recaived information that the group had left the morning of October 27 destination unknown. No further information.

Lieut Stanko, Lieut Sandino and Condega (NA) guardia patrol cleared Condega For halfway to Pueblo Nuevo. Lieut Sandino joined the Pueblo Nuevo patrol. Lieut Sandino and patrol returned to Condega.

Lieut Livermore and Totogalpa (NA) guardia patrol cleared Totogalpa for vicinity of Guapinol, northwest of Yalaguina on police mission. Returned with two prisoners.

Lieut Sandino and Puebho Nuevo (NA) guardia patrol cleared with supplies and orders for another: Pueblo Nuevo patrol laying in ambush in vicinity of La Calera. Patrols returned; nothing to report.

Lieut Griffith, Lieut Hicks and Telpaneca (NA) guardia patrol cleared Telpaneca for and arrived Ocotal.

Lieut Clark and Daraili (NA) guardia patrol returned to Darali from vicinity of Los Planos. Reports that a small group of about fifteen bandits, poorly armed, passed through Los Planos in the afternoon of October 27. Patrol arrived at 11.00 p.m., October 27 and followed trail until ..30 ..., October 28, when patrol was challenged by what was believed to be a bandit sentry. Patrol did not answer the challenge but proceeded along the trail to the place where the challenge came from. Upon arrival found nothing but an abandoned house. Patrol proceeded to reconnoiter all nearby places but was unable to overtake or find definite signs of bandits.

Lieut Vogel and Pataste (NA) guardia patrol cleared Pataste on combat mission to southwestern segovia. Returned with three civil prisoners; destroyed one casusa still in Savanas and captured the owner.

29 OCTOBER 1931

Dipilto (NA) guardia patrol cleared Dipilto for and arrived Ocotal. Lieut Berueffy and patrol cleared Ocotal for and arrived Dipilto.

Captain Tebbs and Jicaro (NA) guardia patrol cleared Jicaro for and arrived Apali.

Lieut Delgadillo, Lieut Whiteford and San Juan de Telpaneca (NA) guardia patrol cleared San Juan for and arrived Quilali.

Captain Good and Ocotal (NA) guardia patrol cleared Ocotal fo and arrived Totogalpa. Cleared Totogalpa and returned to Ocotal.

Captain O'Leary and Pueblo Nuevo (NA) guardia patrol cleared Pueblo Nuevo for halfway to Condega. Captain Holdahl and Condega (NA) guardia patrol cleared Condega for halfway to Pueblo Nuevo. Patrols met. Captain Holdahl joined the Puebol Nuevo patrol and returned with it to Pt. 10 Nuevo. Condega patrol returned to home station.

Lieut Burt and Totogalpa (NA) guardia patrol cleared for and arrived Yalaguina. Cleared Yalaguina and returned to Totogalpa.

l. A patrol from Yalaguina cleared on combat mission to La Muta (194-358) via Rio Abajo (194-354) at 0400 October 12, 1931. The patrol consisted of the following named Officer and enlisted men:

- 2. As the patrol was approaching La Muta I caused it to divide, sending four men with BAR to the right, four men with STMG to the left. I with two enlisted and the guide went straight forward. The three divided units entered the clearing at the same time about seventy yards apart, already deployed as skirmishers. As we entered the clearing we were fired upon from a hill about two hundred yards to the front. The fire was returned immediately by the patrol who advanced on both sides of clearing. On ascending the hill the underbrush was so thick that grenades could not be used to any advantage.
- 3. The fire lasted for about ten minutes with the guardia advancing steadily. The bandits were driven from the hill and scattered in all directions. We chased the largest group, possibly six or eight in number, toward Sabana Grande but they divided and all signs of them were lost.
- 4. We returned to the place of contact, which we searched very carefully, finding a well hidden house which had been used as a camp. The were cow hide, beds, blankets and hammocks for about lifteen men.

Time of contact: seven forty five; fire lasted for about ten minutes.

Guardia casualties: None. Bandit Casualties: Unknown.

Guardia employed one ELR, one STIG, eight rifles, and one pistol. Bandits used rifles and pistols.

Guardia captured two cutachas, two machetes, four blankets, two hammocks, two guitars, about twenty five pounds Toboacco, twenty pairs of Kyitesseveral lairets, red hat bands, hats, and various articles of wearing apparel. The camp was burned.

5. The men were obedient and conducted themselves in an excellent manner. Patrol cleared for Yalaguina via Sabana Grande at nine hundred forty five.

The following report of a patrol, made by Lieut. J. A. Burns, G.W., and Chinandega guardia, and describing some of the conditions existing in the Department of Chinandega, is quoted:

HEADQUARTERS, GUARDIA NACIONAL, CHINANDEGA NICARAGUA. 22 October 1931.

From: 2nd Lieut. John A. Burns, G.N.
To: Department Commander, Department of Chinandega, Chinandega, Nic.

Subject: Patrol report.

Reference: Verbal orders, Department Commander.

- 1. In accordance with the above reference, a Guardia patrol, consisting of myself and four (4) enlisted men, cleared Chinandega at 0745 October 19, 1931. The mission of the patrol was to cover the area South-East, East, North-East of Chinandega; to interview the people living in this area, especially the owners of the larger haciendas, to get information regarding the general conditions existing in that part of the Department.
- 2. Arrived at the hacienda "Philadelfia" at 0910. The forman here reported that cattle were killed and the most carried off at more or less regular intervals. He is of the opinion that the persons responsible are from Chinandega. Three (3) men from Chinandega were reported to have passed through the hacienda this same morning. This condition has always existed and is not being carried on to any greater extent at present than in the past.

Passed through Santa Rosa at 1000 and San Nt-colas at 1145. Both places had nothing to report and said

that all was very quiet. Arrived at El Tercero at 1300. No information. Arrived San Antonio at 1430, where the

patrol remained for the night.

Cleared San Antonio at 0700. Lieut. Dumas with one (1) enlisted joined the patrol here. Arrived San Francisco at 1000. all quiet. Arrived Limon 1100. This is a group of five (5) or seven (7) families, squatters, living on the property of San Antonio without permission. Permission has been granted them to remain until after harvest time. Patrol arrived at El Polvon at 1430. Stayed here over night.

Cleared El Polvon at 0700. Arrived San Ramon at 0900. All quiet. San Pablo at 1100. This is a coffee and cattle ranch. The manager reported men armed with shotguns hunt door on the finea, and that cattle are killed and carried off, but that this is not any worse than at all times previous. He thinks that the hunters kill cattle in lieu of deer when the latter cannot be found. Arrived Posoltoga at 1145 and cleared for Sanjones where patrol arrived at 1300. Pastor Quesada was captured here on information received from Chinandega while the patrol was in Posoltega. At Sanjones we met the forman of the finca La Joya. He had just come down from the finca and reported all to be very quie and that he did not know of any robberies or of the persons supposed to have committed same. Arrived San Sirama at 1530. No information. Captured one (1) man with a shotgun, powder and bullets. Arrived Chichigalpa at 1800 and remained overnight.

Cleared Chichigalpa at 0700 with four enlisted, Lieutement Dumes and one (1) enlisted remaining in Chichigalpa. Arrived at the finca of Humberto Alvarado at 1000. This finea is at the foot of El Chonco. Everything was reported to be quiet in this section.

Arrived Chinandega at 1230.

- The places mentioned above are the larger fincas. Many small fineas or farms were passed and at all times and from all of them the same information was obtained; that all was peaceful and that they did not know of any robberies or any other offenses committed in their vicinity.
- The people in general were working and going about their various occupations in a cheerful manner and seemed to think that conditions were as well as, if not better, than they have been for some time.
- Roads and trails travelled, while muddy, are considered to be in a fair condition.
